VENEZUELA

Day 1 - To Caracas

Arrival at the airport 2 hours prior to your flight to Caracas, Venezuela. Don't forget your tickets and passport! Upon arrival, your Venezuelan hosts from the Gaudeamus Arts Center will meet you at the airport with your air-conditioned motorcoach. After retrieving your baggage, transfer to the Caracas Anauco Hilton.

Day 2 - Caracas



Breakfast followed by a morning excursion to the city center. This afternoon you will have time to prepare for a performance at a church or at the local military base. You'll have a large and appreciative audience – there will also be time to visit a private beach area, so bring your suits! Your guide can suggest places to visit after dinner. When navigating Caracas' somewhat haphazard city plan, it is good to remember that the ever-present Mount Avila looms to the north. Downtown, which is not located in the city center but to the northeast, is laid out in a reliable grid system. Many of Caracas' popular stores and restaurants are located in the northwest areas

of Altamira and Los Palos Grandes; in Bellos Monte, Chacaito and Sabana Grande located southwest of Altamira and east of downtown; and in Las Mercedes, situated southeast of downtown.

Day 3 – Caracas

Breakfast with a free morning. Perhaps you would like to relax by the pool or attempt mountain climbing. Lunch at the hotel with the afternoon free for rest and performance preparation. Concert at a local theatre. Return to the Hilton where you will have dinner and an evening in the city.



Day 4 - Caracas

Free day in town.

Day 5 - Maturin, Carupano, Cumana, Puerto la Cruz-Barcelona



These towns are near or on the beach and there will be beach time for the group at each area we stop in. Your local hosts will be music organizations. There will also be time to interact with the Warao Indians living on the canals and delta islands. From the Delta to Caripe it's about 4 hours, from Caripe to Cumana, 2 1/2; therefore we are leaving this day for travel amongst the

villages, meeting time with the local Indians and for travel.

Day 6 - Delta Amacuro

After breakfast and more time with the local people, you will present the performance that was prepared yesterday at the Teatro Oriwakanoco.

Day 7 - Beach time!

Today is a day to relax in one of the finest beach towns in the group. Enjoy a relaxing day and get in some shopping, too!

Day 8 - Cumana, Estado Sucre

Today's performance will be very exciting. Although Cumana is the capital of Sucre state, they have no real auditorium of any size, so they set up a stage on the street between the orchestra and the steps of the Santa Ines church. 14 dance and theatrical groups have recently performed there in a festival, and the events are always very well assisted. Another FAF group did this concert stop and said it was one of the most fantastic concerts. The facade of the church is lit up at night.

An early morning transfer to the Caracas airport for your return flight to the USA.
